

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Greetings,

Our club is open to all Airsoft players interested in safe and sane play. The scenarios and game play are designed to imitate modern day warfare. We welcome all to come and enjoy!

As of January 2007 the Mike Force club has made membership and participation in the following 4 categories:

Guests: All our guests are required to come with the attitude of good sportsmanship and agree to play safe and sane according to [Dr King's Tactical Airsoft Game Rules](#). All guests are required to review Dr King's Tactical Airsoft Game Rules prior to arriving to the game site. Those under 18 years of age must have a signed waiver from a parent or guardian; wear sealed paintball style goggles and a football style mouth piece. Any style BDU (Battle Duty Uniform) is acceptable but Woodland style is highly recommended. On arrival to the game site please follow these steps:

1. Arrive early enough to get suited up and ready to play.
2. Go to the SAFETY OFFICER and chronograph all airsoft guns that you intend to use during game play. Bring an empty magazine for each different type gun used.
3. Turn in to the SAFETY OFFICER your [waiver](#) and/or permission slip.
4. Take the multiple choice safety test.
5. Pay the \$15 first time administration fee. The \$5 extra fee is for the RED DEATH BANDANA. Those guests returning pay only \$10 per game day unless indicated for a special event or location.

Fire Team Member: To become a member, a guest must have played a minimum of 3 consecutive Mike Force activities and/or game days and on the 3rd activity request membership. Membership requires that the member complies with the uniformity requirements as listed on the uniformity page. You may request your 1 year membership to be with the Mike Force or The Red Star Opposition Force as available. Members will pay a \$10 administration fee for being out of uniform at games.

Membership is only \$30 dollars per year but please note that members will receive the next year free if they participate in a minimum of 8 Mike Force Club activities per year.

See the illustrations for uniform and patch placement. Fire Team members will be spot

checked for gun safety and must take the safety test if asked by the SAFETY OFFICER or GAME MASTER.

Recondo: Recondo qualified members must have their arrowhead on their uniform and comply with the Fire Team Member uniformity requirements as listed above.

Membership is only \$30 dollars per year but please note that members will receive the next year free if they participate in a minimum of 8 Mike Force Club activities per year.

Elite: These members are chosen for their extra ordinary playing skills and participation in all club activities. In order to maintain Elite status the member must participate in a minimum of 8 Mike Force activities per year or will be dropped back down to Recondo (if a graduate) or Fire Team Member status. There is no yearly fee for Elite status but the member is expected to assist in administrative activities as required by the clubs Game Master such as a SAFETY OFFICER. Occasionally there may be an extra fee for away games and special events such as the annual Special Forces Turkey Shoot.

Past members that are not current with their membership will be considered as guests, pay the guest fee or pay the annual administration fee and if desired to go through the membership process as listed above.

The purpose of the Safety test is to ensure all members understand the rules to play safe and sane. By taking the safety test, time will be saved.

The guest and members will only have to go to the game scenario briefing; thus faster starting time and longer game play!
